Lake Quivira's opening hole is a picturesque straight away Par 4. Elevated tees play to a generous sized fairway, keep it down the middle and do not be surprised to see birdies made on the very first hole. Avoid being long and left on your approach, this green sets atop a hill and long shots can be difficult to get up and down.

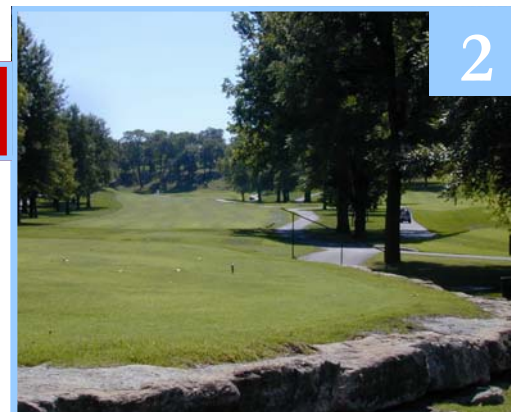

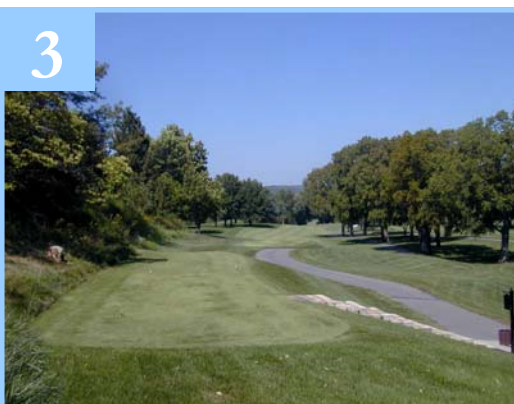

The second longest Par 5 on the course, Hole #2 presents a challenge. Attempts to reach the green in two are often foiled by the left greenside pond and stream. A multi-tier green offers several difficult front and back pin locations.

Hole #3 is a strong Par 4, tee shots are best played down the left hand side of this sloping fairway. Trees guard both sides of the fairway and approach shots can be tricky. Be sure to avoid the greenside bunker on the right.

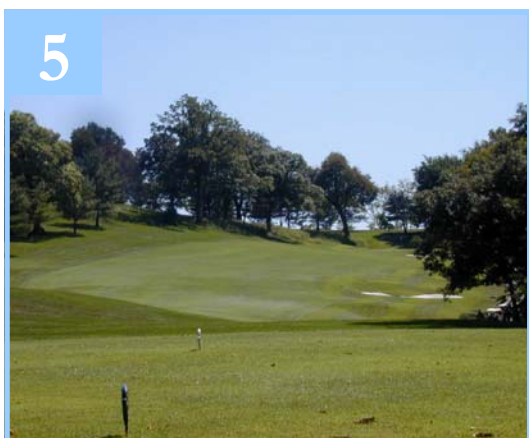
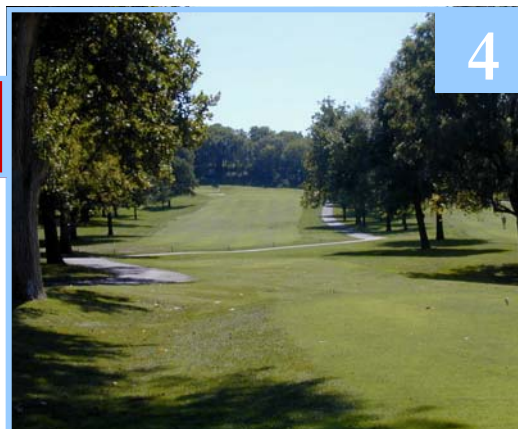

This up-hill Par 4 is the number one handicap hole at Lake Quivira. A solid tee shot must be complimented by a long iron or hybrid. Hitting this large green in two does not guarantee par. Take your time reading the subtle breaks to avoid a three put.



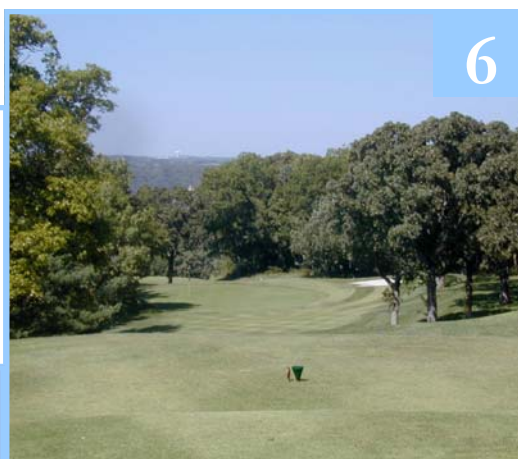

Hole #5 is the shortest Par 4 on the front nine. Many players will opt for driver off the tee but hybrids and irons are common. The large fairway plays to a relatively flat green, avoid missing your approach right, greenside bunkers await.

The first Par 3 on the front nine is a real beauty. The down hill tee shot will leave many players second guessing which club to hit. Front and left pin placements remain on the lower tear of this green, yet pins set back and right will require high-quality lag putts to secure a par.

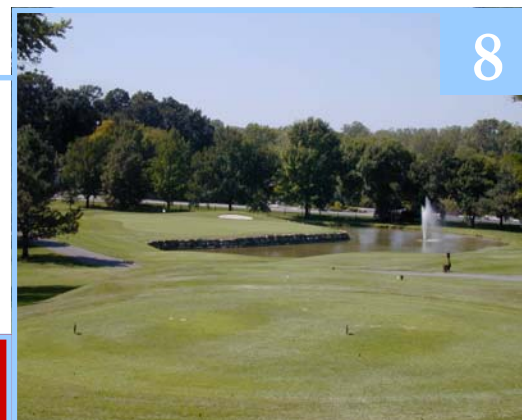

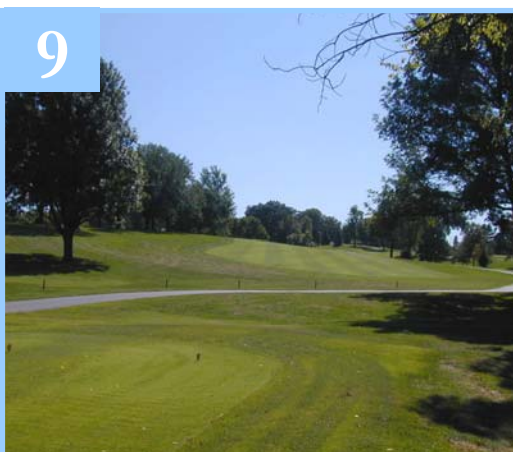
Hole #7 is a medium length Par 5 that plays host to one of the most spectacular views on the golf course. Be sure to avoid the out-of-bounds markers that line the right hand side of this hole. The green boast front and back tiers, pin location is important when making your club selection.

The Par 3 Eighth is considered one of Lake Quivira's signature holes. A water feature complete with a fountain lines the front and right sides of this green, creating an intimidating yet enjoyable tee shot. This hole produces frequent birdies and has seen it's share of Ace's.

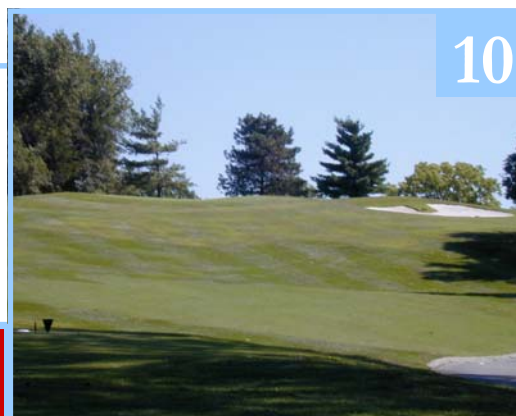

The back nine opens with a simple uphill Par 3, the first of three uphill par 3's on this side. Mid-irons played to the middle of this green will allow for very legitimate birdie opportunities. Players will want to avoid the deep greenside bunker guarding the right portion of this green.

Hole #11 is a visually appealing dog-leg right that boast an elevated green. Fairway bunkers and a large tree reek havoc for any tee shots that stray off to the right. Hybrids or fairway woods are an option from this tee, driver is however the most common play.

Atop the Twelfth tee box is another amazing view of Lake Quivira. This straight away Par 4 offers the player another opportunity for a birdie. A short approach plays to a two tier green, the lowest tier is located back-left, presenting a difficult two putt.

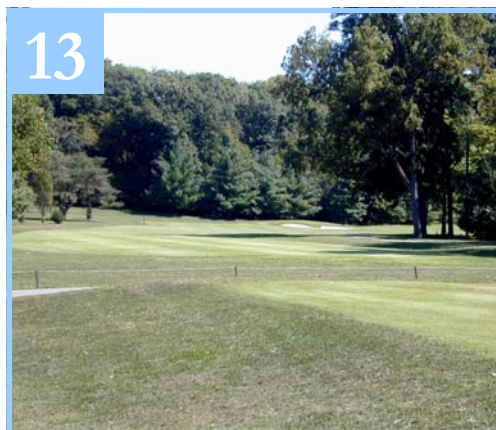

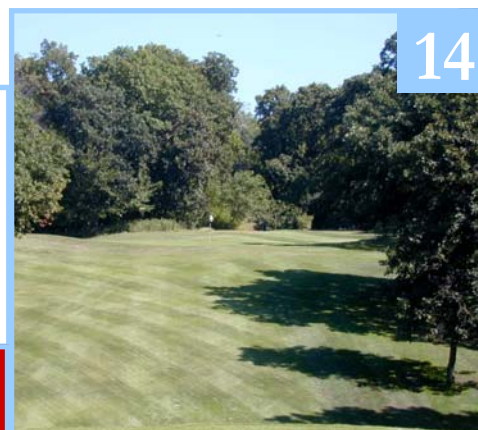

Hole #13 is a modest Par 4 with an aggressive dog-leg right. Driver is an option off the tee box but you must avoid the fairway bunker. The approach is navigated over water with bunkers guarding both sides of the green. Check your distance because looks can be deceiving particularly on this ap-

Club selection is once again key with this short uphill Par 3. Avoid missing the green right, trees abound and hinder chip shots. Hitting the green does not guarantee a two put par, Hole #14 is know for it's tricky pin placements and long putts with multiple breaks.

The tree lined Par 5 Fifteenth presents players with a jovial challenge. Tee shots must land short of a cross creek, while the second shot is played at a sloping fairway. A water feature and bunker guard the left hand side of a generous sized green. Eagle is a difficult feat on this hole.

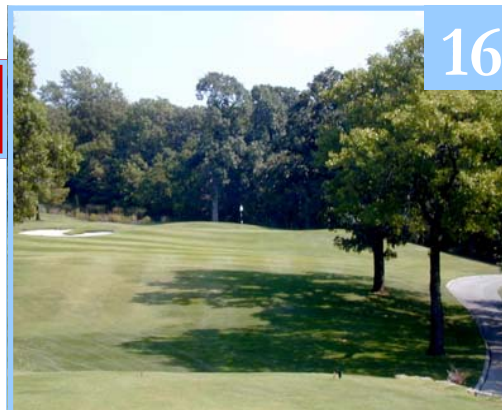

Hole #16 is the third and final up-hill Par 3 on the back nine. Club selection here will be very similar to that made on Hole #10. Two putts are most easily made from the middle portion of this green, be mindful of the prevalent slope on the front edge of this green.



The final Par 4 at Lake Quivira offers players a challenging first shot, tee balls need to reach the fairway plateau while avoiding trouble left. Approach shots can appear deceptively short, make sure you have enough club especially if the pin is located at the back left of this green.

Hole #18 is the shortest Par 5 at Lake Quivira offering players one last chance to make birdie. Eagle is a definite possibility for players willing to take the risk, missing this green long brings bogey into play. Hole #18 is a rewarding finish to our picturesque and memorable golf course.
